

## **SUMMARY ANNUAL REPORT FOR WEBBER, LLC WELFARE BENEFIT PLAN**

This is a summary of the annual report of the Webber, LLC Welfare Benefit Plan, a health, life insurance, dental, vision, temporary disability and long-term disability plan (Employer Identification Number 74-2454910, Plan Number 501), for the plan year 01/01/2017 through 12/31/2017. The annual report has been filed with the Employee Benefits Security Administration, as required under the Employee Retirement Income Security Act of 1974 (ERISA).

Webber, LLC has committed itself to pay certain Health, Dental, Vision claims incurred under the terms of the plan.

### **Insurance Information**

The plan has insurance contracts with UNUM LIFE INSURANCE COMPANY OF AMERICA and THE LINCOLN NATIONAL LIFE INSURANCE COMPANY to pay certain Life insurance, Group Long Term Care, Voluntary Life, AD&D, Temporary disability, Long-term disability, Accident, Critical Illness, AD&D claims incurred under the terms of the plan. The total premiums paid for the plan year ending 12/31/2017 were \$1,663,257.
