

## “Ferrovial Together COVID-19” fund donates €8.7 million for healthcare equipment, research and social assistance

- Food aid and social assistance totaling €4.235 million has been allocated to at-risk populations via Caritas, World Vision, CESAL, World Central Kitchen, The Trussell Trust Food Banks, Ayuda en Acción, Action against Hunger, the Red Cross, food banks and other organizations in Spain, the United Kingdom, the United States, Chile, Colombia, Peru, Poland and Portugal
- Vaccine research received €900,000 to support work at University of Oxford, Spain's National Centre for Biotechnology, and Baylor Medical College in the US.
- The company is distributing 900,000 FFP2 masks, 117,000 diagnostic tests and 90 ventilators to various health services in Spain and the UK (NHS), the Peruvian Ministry of Health, and the Red Cross in Colombia and Poland. This item amounts to €3.555 million.

**Madrid, 27/07/2020** – Ferrovial has completed the distribution of €8.69 million out of the “Ferrovial Together COVID-19” fund, through organizations fighting the pandemic in the social, healthcare and research dimensions, in Spain, the United Kingdom, the United States, Chile, Peru, Colombia, Poland and Portugal. That is the total amount of aid distributed to date, and includes the figures disclosed on 8 and 28 May.

The health crisis is having a major economic impact, especially on families that were already in a vulnerable situation. The effect of the pandemic has increased the number of people in a situation of social risk, who are also experiencing greater difficulty in meeting basic needs such as food, hygiene products and medicine. Ferrovial has donated €4.235 million to prestigious institutions in this field. They include Caritas, CESAL, World Vision and World Central Kitchen, in Spain; The Trussell Trust Food Bank, in the UK; various food banks and World Central Kitchen, in the United States; Techo, in Chile; Action Against Hunger, in Colombia; CESAL and Ayuda en Acción, in Peru; and the Red Cross in Portugal and Poland. This aid will reach around 115,000 people, enabling the distribution of 1,710,000 meals.

The company has allocated €3.555 million in the medical field to purchase 830,000 FFP2 masks, 70,000 surgical masks, 117,000 diagnostic tests, 90 ventilators, and other medical and personal protective equipment, for donation to Spanish regional governments, including Madrid, Valencia, Castilla-La Mancha, Andalusia, Catalonia, Cantabria and the Canary Islands. Part of this contribution is being distributed via government agencies and NGOs in other countries, such as the United Kingdom, Chile, Colombia, Peru, Poland and Portugal.

Ferrovial, which is making major efforts to combat the pandemic, is also supporting research to develop a vaccine for the SARS-CoV-2 coronavirus, which is the cause of the COVID-19 pandemic. It has donated €500,000 to University of Oxford, which is undertaking one of the most advanced projects to develop a vaccine. It also allocated €250,000 for two vaccine projects at Spain's National Centre for Biotechnology, which is part of the Spanish National Research Council (CSIC), and €150,000 to Baylor College of Medicine, in Texas, which is working to develop a vaccine that modifies the virus proteins.

Spain is the country that has received the largest share of funds to date (€5 million), followed by the United States (€1.33 million) and the United Kingdom (€1 million). Other recipients are Peru (€435,000), Colombia (€380,000), Chile (€200,000), Poland (€150,000) and Portugal (€195,000).

Ferrovial set up the “Ferrovial Together COVID-19” fund with an initial endowment of €5 million from the company. At the same time, it launched a drive to raise funds among employees, directors, shareholders, contractors, suppliers and anyone wishing to make a contribution, based on the company's commitment to double all donations. To date, the “Ferrovial Together COVID-19” fund has raised €8.690 million through contributions by Ferrovial and third parties.

## A commitment to fighting COVID-19

The company is strongly committed to combating the pandemic, having participated in a number of initiatives, such as setting up a temporary hospital at the Madrid convention center, and developing the “CoronaMadrid” website and app, along with other companies, in partnership with the Madrid Regional Government, to facilitate patient diagnosis and monitoring so as to avoid saturating the healthcare facilities and reduce the numbers requiring emergency care.
